The Fred Harris U.S. Congressional Internship Program seeks students who have (1) a commitment to public service as well as (2) an interest in having an academically rigorous internship experience. In order for both objectives to be met, successful applicants are evaluated on the basis of both academic criteria and on UNM's ability to place them in offices wherein they have the opportunity to work toward policy goals that they embrace and in environments that allow them to maximize career and networking opportunities in policy areas that they find most important.

Complete the following application and submit with it (1) a <u>résumé</u>, (2) <u>two letters of recommendation</u> and (3) an <u>unofficial transcript</u> from all higher education institutions attended.

All application materials should be emailed to agutierrez174@unm.edu with a cc to tbkrebs@unm.edu. Each letter of recommendation should also be emailed to agutierrez174@unm.edu with cc to tbkrebs@unm.edu directly by the person writing it. At least one letter of recommendation should come from a faculty member from whom you have taken a class and who can thus assess, based on direct observation, your academic performance in class on a daily basis and on graded assignments.
